This submission is a consultation response to the local plan consultation with deadline 13 December 2021. It provides additional information regarding a site that we put forward as landowner to the Call for Sites. The submission makes the case for reconsidering the site, Heydon End reference no. 47352, for approval for further consideration in the local plan.

It briefly sets out the policy context, then provides information on two parish surveys carried out by Heydon Parish Council which show local support for the Heydon End site, and types of development favourable to Heydon End. I also provide further information and corrections to the HELAA assessment of this site, with important information and corrections relating to many of the issues, including corrections to the Availability of Services issue which is the only one which was classed as "red". There is also a mistake in the assessment in terms of constraints because the assessment did not use the definitive rights of way map to check the line of a footpath which actually does not cross the Heydon End site.
