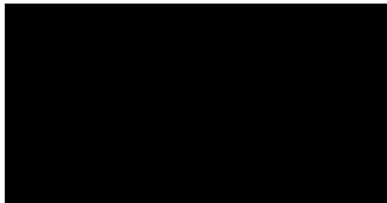
Our reasons for supporting this ambitious project are as follows:
