

The Royal London Mutual Insurance Society Ltd response to Policy S/JH

The latest evidence on need in Greater Cambridge undertaken by Icenl in 2025, identified an objectively assessed need for 73,200 jobs over the plan period 2024–2045. We acknowledge that a minimum of this scale of growth is needed to support the knowledge-intensive sectors, including life sciences and technology, while also supporting a diverse range of employment opportunities. However, we suggest that this figure will likely need to evolve to align with the Government’s broader growth agenda whilst ensuring the vision can be achieved sustainably.

Cambridge Research Park, Landbeach and Vision Park, Histon are sustainably located, established and strategically important employment destinations that already make a significant contribution to Greater Cambridge’s science and technology clusters. These locations are well placed from a public transport and access to homes perspective, to accommodate further growth through intensification and redevelopment, helping to deliver additional jobs in accessible locations in Greater Cambridge.
