Amateur botanists, wildlife and biodiversity enthusiasts have confirmed sightings of the flora and fauna as follows:

FLORA

Dog Violet, Mouse Ear, Common Mallow, Cut leaf cranes-bill, Hedgerow cranes-bill, White Clover, Vetch, Bee Orchid, Cowslip, Cow Parsley, Yellow Rattle, Mistletoe, Cinquefoil, Rosebay Willowherb, Common Speedwell, Dead Nettle, Bugle, Water Forget-me-not, Hoary Plantain, Ribwort Plantain, Lady's Bedstraw, Cleavers, Woodruff, Ragwort, Spear Thistle, Creeping Thistle, Dandelion, Goat's Beard, Daisy, Hawkbit, Bristly Oxtongue, Sow thistle, Lords and Ladies, Meadow Buttercup, Common Celandine, various sedges and rushes

FUNGI

Common Jellyspot, Pleated Inkcap, Two-toned Wood Tuft, Clavaria, Meadow Waxcap, Cow Pat Fungi, Jelly Cup Fungi, Trametes, Chicken of the woods, Horse Mushroom, Orange peel, Dryad's saddle.

Badhamia Utricularis, Cladonia Fimbriata
